ALL SOULS' DAY

During the month of November, we are called in a special way to remember "our brothers and sisters who have fallen asleep in the hope of the resurrection."

November 1st: All Saints Day This is a Holy Day of Obligation. Mass will be celebrated at 8:00AM & 7:00PM

November 2nd: All Souls Day Rooted in ancient Christian tradition (2nd Century). St Odilo of Cluny established a memorial of all the faithful departed in 988. It was accepted in Rome in the 13th century.

There is an "All Souls' Envelope" included in the offertory envelopes. For parishioners who don't receive envelopes, there are extra All Souls envelopes in each pew and in the vestibule. Please list the names of dearly departed on the front of envelope; these names will be included in our Book of Remembrance which will be on display for the month of November until the beginning of Advent.

Please note, all Masses in November will be offered either for the People of the Parish or for the names in the Book of Remembrance.

TODO EL DÍA DE ALMAS

Durante el mes de noviembre, somos llamados de manera especial a recordar "a nuestros hermanos y hermanas que se han dormido en la esperanza de la resurrección."

1^o de noviembre: Día de Todos los Santos Este es un Día Santo de Obligación. La Misa se celebrará a las 8 de la mañana y a las 7 de la tarde.

2 de noviembre: Día de Todos los Fieles Difuntos. Arraigado en la antigua tradición cristiana (siglo 2). San Odilo de Cluny estableció un memorial de todos los fieles difuntos en 988. Fue aceptado en Roma en el siglo 13.

Hay un sobre "All Souls" incluido en los sobres del ofertorio que se les enviaron por correo. Para los feligreses que no reciben sobres por correo, hay sobres extras en cada banca y en la entrada principal de la iglesia. Por favor apunte los nombres de los queridos difuntos. Estos nombres serán incluidos en nuestro Libro de Recuerdos, cual estará en exhibición durante el mes de noviembre, hasta el comienzo del Adviento.

Por favor, tenga en cuenta que todas las Misas en noviembre serán ofrecidas para el Pueblo de la Parroquia o para los nombres en el Libro de Recuerdos.
