RIO VISTA & ISLETON CLUB

Our Portuguese club is devoted to Queen and Saint Isabel, and the actions of the Holy Spirit in her. The coronation dance is at the Portuguese Hall, 795 S. 7th Street, beginning about 8:30PM on Saturday, August 4th. There will be a special Holy Ghost Festa Mass on Sunday, August 5th at 11:30AM and all are welcome. There will not be a Spanish Mass this weekend. Many area clubs will march in the parade on Sunday morning, August 5th. The parade starts at the Portuguese Hall at 10:30AM on its way to St. Joseph Church via 7th Street, Main St., and California Street. The first open seating feeding of the traditional sopas will be served at the Portuguese Hall about 10:30AM while the parade is in route. The parade feeding will begin when the parade arrives at the Portuguese Hall and is for those who participated in the Festa Mass and parade. Passes are distributed during Mass. There will be an auction on Sunday beginning about 2:00PM. Throughout the day there are linguica sandwiches and sweet bread available, until sold out. There is the traditional Twister booth, cake booth, and Portuguese vendors. There is an additional open seating feeding of sopas following the conclusion of the auction at about 5:30PM. This will be a special weekend for us and we would like to share it with you.

Las donaciones hechas con cheque deben hacerse a nombre de la parroquia. Todos los fondos recaudados en todas las diócesis
