St. Vincent de Paul announces its major fund-raising event, **“FRIENDS OF THE POOR WALK on Saturday, September 22, 2018.”** Our local St. Joseph Conference was formed just over four years ago. Since then our 25 Vincentians disbursed \$45,773.00 in aid to 341 families in the Rio Vista area. Two years ago, we started a furniture storage unit that picks up donated furniture and redistributes it to families in need, with the assistance of 12 volunteers. Now, for the first time, our local conference will participate in the national event, “Friends of the Poor Walk”, to raise money for our work. To bring awareness to the challenges faced by those in need, we are providing free t-shirts to all children registered to walk, and to registered adults for a \$20.00 donation. Registration begins at 8 AM in our parking lot. The walk starts at 9:AM and circles around the park. More active walkers can proceed down Main Street and return to the parking lot, a ½ mile stroll. Water and juices will be available. Please put this important fund-raising event on your calendar.
